Our initiatives include

- Target 2 teachers to attend Regional workshops on Lyn Sharratt's work and share this with whole school team.
- Enhance capabilities of staff across all KLA's through the implementation of the Australian Curriculum and Harrisville State School Reading and Numeracy Framework. Targeted focus on identified key strategies and resources.
- Continued case management of students including 'Closing the Gap' students to inform individual student learning.

- Access Regional PD to assist building towards an expert teaching team.
- Accessing relevant PD and releasing teachers to speak to a coach.
- Developing leadership team by participating in Regional workshops with Lyn Sharratt.
